ORGAN DONATION - IT'S A LAW NOW!

The State of Illinois has just joined 43 other states in starting First Person Consent for all organ donors. This major change means that when a person signs up to be a donor now that this decision will be honored without consent of the family. The family will be advised of the decision of the deceased to be a donor and the services to the family will remain in place, but this decision will be final.

It is hoped that this will lead to more than a hundred more transplants will be possible because of this law. If you have a question about the new law you can get more information on the LIFE GOES ON. ORG web site and one can become a donor on line there as well.

April is Donor Awareness Month and you will be seeing a lot of ads about organ donation. Please take this time to sit down and have a family discussion on this subject so that everyone is comfortable with the organ donor decision. It will help a family deal with a tragedy in a positive way. Organ donation is good for the donor, their family, and the 91,000 plus who are waiting for the Gift of Life.
