
Congratulation to President Maryann for being awarded the "Stump" award this past weekend at Spring Fling in Columbus OH. Well-deserved, my friend.

Mike joined the Springfield Jaycees in September, 1971 where he was quickly recognized and elected to the Board of Directors as External Vice President. He enjoyed being responsible for community activities and projects. In 1973, he served as the Springfield Jaycees Chapter President.

In 1977, Mike was recognized by the Illinois Jaycees as one of the Ten Outstanding Younger Persons. His involvement with the community was vast. Serving as the Vice Chairman of the Springfield Airport Authority, Chairman the Endowment Committee of the Abraham Lincoln Council of the Boy Scouts of America, Chairman of the St. John's College of Nursing, Chairman of Trustees of Western Illinois University, President of the Board of Directors of the Illinois Municipal League, and Chairman of the Springfield Chamber of Commerce.

In 1979, Mike was elected Mayor of Springfield, Illinois serving again in 1983 and returned to office in 2011. He shares the belief of Jaycees that everyone has a duty to give back to the community.
